To vote by paper ballot, place an X on the line in front of the candidate's name. Write-in lines appear below the declared candidates' names for each office. If you want to vote for a write-in candidate, please write that person's name on one of the lines and put an X on the line in front of where you write that person's name.

If more than one person in a household is eligible to vote, then duplication of this ballot is allowed for each eligible member.

Paper ballots must be postmarked no later than January 14, 2022, the day of the OCA General Meeting. Each ballot must be placed in an envelope with the voter's name legibly printed on the envelope; multiple ballots from a family may be put into a single envelope, but the names of **all** voting family members must be printed on the envelope (for confirmation of eligibility to vote). Voting for more than 7 Trustee candidates, or failure to print your name(s) on your ballot envelope, will invalidate your ballot. You may vote electronically or by mail-in paper ballot, but only one ballot is allowed per eligible member; voting more than once will invalidate your ballot.
